Amish Paste 85 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

Amish heirloom variety produces paste-type fruit with an oblong Oxheart shape. 8 ounce tomatoes are solid with an outstandingly good, sweet flavor.

Aussie 85 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

This is one of those varieties to grow when you want a really big, impressive red tomato to show off to your friends. This fruit is huge, at least a pound or two, and borne abundantly on large, vigorous plants. Its flavor is as big as its size, bursting with a great blend of sugars and acids- a full old-fashioned tomato taste. Heirloom variety from Australia.



Big Zac 100 days, Indeterminate



This prize winner was bred by Minnie Zaccaria, a New Jersey gardener who tirelessly sought the perfect cross-pollination of two heirlooms, finally creating this enormous tomato with fruits that repeatedly tip the scales at an amazing 4 to 6 lbs. We know that you'll love it for its quality and its size. An excellent tomato in every respect - meaty and delicious, very disease resistant, and true-growing each time it's planted. Furthermore, it has impeccable ancestors....a beautiful, red

heirloom beefsteak-type, and a large, pink open-pollinated beefsteak heirloom.

Big Rainbow 80-85 days. Indeterminate. Very large, orange fruits with red spots or streaks grow up to 4-1/2" in diameter. Firm, meaty flesh with low acidity, produces a delicious flavor that's ideal in a variety of dishes or eaten plain. One of Steve Goto's Favorite.



Black Cherry 65 days, Indeterminate

This is the first truly black cherry tomato we've found, and our own exclusive variety. It is not a plum, but a perfectly round cherry with classic black tomato flavor, sweet yet rich and complex. Fruit picks clean from the stem and is produced in abundance on vigorous, tall plants. These cherries are irresistibly delicious and a unique addition to the color spectrum of cherry tomatoes now available.

Black Krim 69 days, Indeterminate. HEIRLOOM from the Black Sea region of Russia. A most unusual novelty. Fruits are a dark, deep red with dark green shoulders. Interior is a deep red, reddish green color. Sweet and tasty. Extremely early medium sized. Voted, "Best tasting Tomato for 1998. One of Steve Goto's Favorites.





Brandyboy, 80 days, Indeterminate A Burpee Hybrid

A very productive hybrid of Brandywine. For those looking for a highly productive but the same great flavor of Brandywine, This is the answer to the long question of Brandywine productivity. A large pink fruit measuring to 5 inches across. Manageable vines produce soft Heirloom texture, thin skin with that incredible Brandywine flavor. Strong vine are disease resistant.

Brandywine 80 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

This variety is legendary for its very exceptional rich, succulent flavor. Large pink-red fruit can become 1-1/2 lbs. with creamy flesh. Vines grow quite tall and have potato-leaved foliage. An Amish heirloom since 1885.



Bull's Heart (Cuore de Toro) HEIRLOOM 96-98 days, Indeterminate. Magnificent, clear-yellow, globe-shaped fruits of the beefsteak type. weighing up to 16oz., creamy taste on the tongue. Vigorous, potato-leaved plants are unique in such a large-fruited, Red /yellow variety.

Carmelo 70 days, Indeterminate. A winner on all counts, taste, productivity and disease resistance. It's popular in European markets because of its exceptional fine flavor. The pure essence of tomato, a perfect balance of sweet and acid. Carmelo bears large corps of heavy, juicy, full-flavored tomatoes and the widely adapted, disease-resistant plants yield huge harvests of crack-resistant fruits with a high weight -to-size ratio.



Cherokee Chocolate 75 days, Indeterminate

A stabilized version of Cherokee Purple, this 10 to 16 oz. mahogany-colored variety has excellent flavor and beautiful large fruit. Very productive plants are vigorous and yield a large harvest of these chocolate-colored tomatoes with the ample size and wonderful flavor associated with Cherokee Purple.

Cherokee Purple 80 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

Very productive plants bear loads of 10 to 12 oz. dusky rose/purple fruit with deep brick red interiors. The tomatoes are absolutely delicious with a pleasantly sweet and rich flavor. With thin skin and soft flesh, the fruit is somewhat perishable, but they taste so good they will be eaten quickly anyhow. Heirloom from Tennessee



Copia 80 days, Indeterminate

These very beautiful tomatoes are a stunning combination of fine-lined golden yellow and red stripes. While visually exciting, the real treat comes when you cut them open. Their gold flesh is streaked with red and is very juicy, flavorful, and sweet. A stabilized cross between Green Zebra and Marvel Stripe, these tomatoes weigh about onepound each, They were named in honor of Copia, the American Center for Food, Wine and the Arts, in Napa California. Costoluto Genovese 78 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

Italian heirloom tomatoes. Large, deep-red, juicy tomatoes are deeply ribbed but fully flavored and absolutely delicious. This variety is hearty and does well in hot weather, but continues to produce even when the weather turns cool.





Delicious 77 days, Indeterminate

Huge red fruit is smooth, nearly solid and often weighs more than 2 lbs. excellent flavor, tiny seed cavities, and very little cracking. This is the variety that holds the world record for the largest tomato ever grown. Indeterminate.

Goliath, 65 days, Indeterminate, VFFNTAST

Large smooth bright-red, deep oblate fruit averaging to 15oz. Large yield of blemish free traditional tasting fruit. Moderately disease resistant. An early producer as well as a late producer. Easy to grow in containers. Great White



Green Zebra 75 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

A unique and delicious salad tomato. 3 oz. green fruits ripen to amber-green with darker green stripes. The light green flesh is very flavorful, sweet yet zingy. This one is a real taste treat.

Hawaiian Pineapple 95 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

Golden-orange beefsteak fruit grow up to 1-1/2 lbs. and have a pineapple-like flavor when perfectly ripe. Fruits are deep orange and incredibly rich, fruity and sweet. As a bonus, you can expect very large harvests of these wonderful tomatoes.



Limmony 78days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

These bright lemon-yellow beefsteak tomatoes have a fabulous tangy flavor that is actually sort of lemony, and very clean and crisp. This pronounced acid flavor sets it apart from many other yellow varieties, which are milder in taste. Fruit typically weigh 8 to 10 ozs. and are smooth and blemish-free, with solid, meaty interiors. Healthy plants are quite productive, resulting in great yields of these outstanding tomatoes. Heirloom from Russia.

Momotaro 78 days, Indeterminate

popular tomato in Japan, where gardeners prefer their tomatoes flavored. Hybrid plants produce abundant crops of round, medium-smooth tomatoes with no blemishes or imperfections. Their taste is intensely rich and sweet, with just the right amount of acid. We variety will also catch on with American gardeners once they find it is.

Mule Team 78 days Indeterminate. Heirloom Saved by generations of gardeners and reintroduced because of its enduring qualities: vigorous fruit set, round, medium-sized, red globes that weigh 8-1/2 oz. and are 2-1/2 to 3" across, with a sweet, mild flavor. Meaty, textured fruits are produced continuously until frost on sturdy plants.

Neve's Azorean Red 75 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

This terrific red tomato was developed by Anthony Neve's, who brought seeds from the Azores to the Boston area. There he kept selecting for larger size, resulting in a huge, beautiful beefsteak with 1 to 3 lb. deep red fruit bursting with magnificent, rich flavor. Seed was passed on to Carolyn Male, who shared it with us. This very big and flavorful tomato is perfect for the ultimate tomato sandwich or to showcase in a special tomato salad.



Orange Strawberry Tomato 80 days, Indeterminate Heirloom. Lovely, heart-shaped fruits have sharp tips and are almost blemish-free. Strong, sweet taste in juicy fruits that are a vibrant, deep orange in color when mature, averaging 8 oz. to 1 lb. Don't be fooled by the wispy leaves - plants are very vigorous and high yielding.

Pineapple Tomato 85 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

This heirloom tomato is a stand-out in everyone's garden. Bi-colored red and yellow fruit grows very large, up to 2 lbs., and is streaked with red both inside and out. The flavor is wonderful, rich, fruity and sweet. Strong vines bear an abundant crop.



Red Pear Italian 80 days, Indeterminate. Large red pear shaped solid fruit growing up to one pound. No to be mistaken with the cherry type of Red Pear. Excellent flavor. Large yields. Loves warmer climates. Great for salads and for cooking and canning. Heavy producing plant produces fruit over a long season.

Snow White 75 days, Indeterminate

Delightful ivory-colored cherry tomatoes ripen to pale yellow and are deliciously sweet without being sugary. This variety was hybridized by Joe Bratka and seed was

given to us by a local friend who obtained it years ago in a seed swap. This is one you'll find yourself snacking on in the garden because it tastes so good.



Sausage 78 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

Red paste tomatoes up to 6 inches long are very meaty and perfect for mixing in with canning tomatoes or adding to catsup to provide body. This unusual variety is an heirloom and also quite prolific.

Stupice 52 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

From Czechoslovakia, this is an extremely early cold-tolerant tomato that bears an abundance of 2 ounce flavorful and sweet tomatoes. This variety has become a garden favorite for its earliness, productivity, and truly wonderful taste.



Sun Gold Cherry Hybrid 57 days, Indeterminate

Very sweet, bright orange cherry tomatoes taste not just sugary but also fruity and delicious. Vigorous growers, these tall plants bear long clusters of fruit. Try these for a real taste treat, you won't believe you're eating tomatoes!



Sun Sugar 60 days Indeterminate. The ultimate in cherry tomatoes, this golden yellow beauty achieves a new level of sugar-sweetness and flavor, superb texture, and a tangy "true tomato" taste. Fruits are a lovely golden yellow, weigh 1/2 oz., and possess thin skins - remarkable, considering its wonderful crack resistance, even in heavy rains. Heavy early cropper. Very vigorous - can be grown outdoors or indoors in an unheated greenhouse in colder regions.



Sweet Baby Girl Hybrid 65 days, Indeterminate (compact)

a major seed company set out to find a cherry tomato that was extra flavorful and sweet on a productive, but more manageable plant. The result is Sweet Baby Girl, and it does indeed have incredible harvests of tomatoes on healthy, compact plants. Dark red fruit has great, sweet flavor and grows in long clusters. Resistant to tobacco mosaic virus.



Whopper Improved 69 days Indeterminate (VFFNT) Earlier and tastier than the original Whopper, with big red, 4" fruits that feature improved disease and crack-resistance, as well as a more uniform fruit size. You'll start harvesting in just 65 days, and keep picking right until frost! A popular choice for fresh market and home garden. Vigorous, stocky plants.
