Amish Paste 85 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

Amish heirloom variety produces paste-type fruit with an oblong Oxheart shape. 8 ounce tomatoes are solid with an outstandingly good, sweet flavor.

Aunt Ruby's German Green 80 days, Indeterminate, HEIRLOOM Beefsteak fruits are 5 to 6 inches in diameter and weigh one pound or more. Sweet juicy flesh, refreshing spicy flavor. Thick green slices are great in sandwiches. Produces fruit in late season and in cooler climates.



Black Krim 69 days, Indeterminate. HEIRLOOM from the Black Sea region of Russia. A most unusual novelty. Fruits are a dark, deep red with dark green shoulders. Interior is a deep red, reddish green color. Sweet and tasty. Extremely early medium sized. Voted, "Best tasting Tomato for 1998. One of Steve Goto's Favorites.

Carmelo 70 days, Indeterminate. A winner on all counts, taste, productivity and disease resistance. It's popular in European markets because of its exceptional fine flavor. The pure essence of tomato, a perfect balance of sweet and acid. Carmelo bears large crops of heavy, juicy, full-flavored tomatoes and the widely adapted, disease-resistant plants yield huge harvests of crack-resistant fruits with a high weight -to-size ratio.



Cherokee Purple 80 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

Very productive plants bear loads of 10 to 12 oz. dusky rose/purple fruit with deep brick red interiors. The tomatoes are absolutely delicious with a pleasantly sweet and rich flavor. With thin skin and soft flesh, the fruit is somewhat perishable, but they taste so good they will be eaten quickly anyhow. Heirloom from Tennessee

Druzba 80 days, Indeterminate. Bulgarian HEIRLOOM translates as "friendship" round slightly flattened fruit grow to 4in in diameter. Complex flavor of sweet and acid. Good yields of meaty fruit. This is one of Steve Goto's favorites for salads and sandwiches.



Glacier 63 days. Semi-indeterminate. Extremely early . cold-tolerant, high-yielding special strain of tomato plant. Begins flowering when only 4in high and bears tasty tomatoes only 45 days from flowering. Above average yields of 2 to 3 oz sized fruits and outstanding flavor for such an early tomato.

Jaune Flammee 70-80days. apricot-shaped HEIRLOOM from have contrasting reddish interior, great flavor for a small tomato. Very in clusters and weigh 2-3 ounces.



Indeterminate. Beautiful France. Golden-yellow fruits for drying. Excellent bitey productive plants. Fruits borne



Jetsetter Hybrid 64 days, Indeterminate. A shoryt season plant that produces medium sized red fruit to 8 ozs. Great traditional flavors of sweet and tartness. Vigorous large plants that have great disease resistant. Produces large yields.



Juliet 60 days, Indeterminate. "1999 AAS winner" The first elongated, grape-like fruits that don't crack. Clusters of unusual, sweet-flavored fruits cling to the vine longer than any other cherry tomato, Glossy, red-skinned fruits weigh 1 oz each.



Momotaro 78 days, Indeterminate

This is the most popular tomato in Japan, where gardeners prefer their tomatoes pink and sweetly flavored. Hybrid plants produce abundant crops of round, medium-sized, perfectly smooth tomatoes with no blemishes or imperfections. Their taste is wonderful, intensely rich and sweet, with just the right amount of acid. We think that this variety will also catch on with American gardeners once they find out how

delicious it is.

Orange Strawberry 80 days. Lovely, heart-shaped fruits have sharp tips and are almost blemish-free. Strong, sweet taste in juicy fruits that are a vibrant, deep orange when mature, averaging 8 oz. Fruits to one pound. Wispy foliage on plants that are vigorous and high yielding.



Pineapple Tomato 85 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM

This heirloom tomato is a stand-out in everyone's garden. Bi-colored red and yellow fruit grows very large, up to 2 lbs., and is streaked with red both inside and out. The flavor is wonderful, rich, fruity and sweet. Strong vines bear an abundant crop.

San Marzano (Super) 80 days. Indeterminate. More rectangular-shaped paste-type and slightly later than Roma. Truly excellent flavor for soups, sauces and catsup. Fruits (3-1/2" by 1-1/2") are intense red and hang in large clusters that hold well on the vine or in storage. Perfect for canning with extra high solids content.



Siberia 48 days. Determinate. Very early variety. A Russian Traveler supposedly smuggled out this seed in 1975 and gave it to a greenhouse operator in Canada. This tomato is capable of setting fruit at 38 degrees on sturdy, dark green plants. Bright red fruits, 3 to 5 ozs. Grow in clusters of 30 or more on small bushy plants. Most popular variety today in Alaska.



Sioux 70 days. Semi-Indeterminate. An excellent variety for areas with hot summer temperatures, since it sets fruit well in spite of the heat and dry conditions. Thick-walled, crack-free, red globes are abundant with an acidic flavor.



Snow White 75 days, Indeterminate. Ivory-colored cherry tomatoes that ripen to a pale yellow. Fruit is deliciously sweet, round, 1/2-inch and borne from productive vines. This has always been a great hit for me with kids, especially those who claimed to not like tomatoes.

Stupice 52 days, Indeterminate HEIRLOOM
From Czechoslovakia, this is an extremely early cold-tolerant tomato that bears an abundance of 2 ounce flavorful and sweet tomatoes. This variety has become a garden favorite for its earliness, productivity, and truly wonderful taste.



Sungold Cherry, 57 days, Indeterminate. Once voted the sweetest tomato ever by discerning English Gardeners. A positively luscious, bite size golden beautiful overflowing with an abundance of fruits. Thin-skinned, with a juicy flesh that holds its sweet-fresh-from-the-vine flavor. Golden orange, small, round, Very early, and a heavy cropper both indoors and in greenhouses. Cascading trusses are smothered in fruits that remain ripe and ready for picking over long periods of time. Steve Goto says, this one is a must in your garden. I love these for an afternoon snack right off the vine.

Sweet Olive F-1 57 days, Indeterminate. Sweet, bite-size, firm, oval-shaped grape tomatoes are bright red and bursting with flavor. Outstanding in our grape tomato trial for color, flavor, texture, and preferred small size. Strong tolerance to heat, humidity, and cracking.
